Homes for *Computers*



Voluntary Action Center's Homes for Computers program provides reformatted computers donated by the City of Columbia to Columbia families with children in grades K-12. VAC partners with the City of Columbia and the Downtown Optimist Club to put on this program. In 2016, 40 families received a computer, and to date, 483 computers have been given through this program.

Computer distribution takes place at the Downtown Optimist "Friend of Youth" building (1201 Grand Ave.) on **Saturday, February 18, 2017**. At that time, recipients receive training on Internet safety for both children and adults.

Free introductory computer courses are also available on a regular basis at the Daniel Boone Regional Library to help families become more familiar with basic hardware and software components of their computers.

This program will distribute only computers donated by the City of Columbia. VAC is not able to accept other computer donations at this time. Families who have received a computer from VAC in the past are not eligible to receive another.
